Elisabeth Bergeron and the country Patrimony (following)

In 1960, the Sisters of Saint Joseph will be teaching in seventy-seven schools in Quebec. *Instructing children both boys and girls in the elementary schools...never a boarding school for young people* is written in our constitution. Without saying that it was perfection and performance everywhere, we can say that there was much devotedness and love for the children. It was ordinarily with good will that commissioners who would hire the Sisters, often without knowing them!

The institute founded by Elisabeth Bergeron was a desire to answer to a need in society as well as the beginning of the West in Canada, especially in Manitoba. About fifteen public schools were founded for the francophone population and six Residential Schools were in charge of the Indian children.

Also, in answer to needs elsewhere in the world, the creation of apostolic fields in Lesotho, Senegal, Tchad and Haïti were created.

Here, in Saint-Hyacinthe, a Junior High School, a Normal School, and a Senior High School were founded. The Senior High School became officially a lay Corporation in 2001 after sixty years of existence, with 1397 students. The program of pedagogy became the originality of the school: "it became the option of the Congregation of the Sisters of Saint-Joseph by giving the priority to the young people without any regard towards their school performance" or the words of the actual director, Mrs. Simone Leblanc, in the journal of Saint-Hyacinthe, a few weeks ago.

November 2013... The Sisters are getting old and their number is diminishing. There are 134 here at the Mother House, in a big building, too big and too heavy to administer. We had to put it on sale.

Elisabeth Bergeron's task will not terminate with our departure from Raymond Avenue. It is incarnated in the patrimony of Quebec. All the students who passed in our schools... "bore fruit, a fruit that remains". But, especially, Elisabeth Bergeron's memory which is still very much alive.

It is convenient to end this statement by coming back to her. We left it when the community was expanding. In as much as this woman seemed fragile when searching for her place while confronting all sorts of contradictions, she had been for the growing community the rock on which all the incertitudes would rest.

Advised, audacious... (land bought, increasing the land of the Mother House), she was often consulted by all the Sisters. She visited the schools. She advised the teachers. (Ex.: « Let your students love school; otherwise they will not learn.")

Her life was very sober (clothing, meals, residence... a room only at the end of her life). She prayed much, often and for long periods. It is surely in these meetings and her serenity which marked her more and more, especially at the end of her life. She spent only a few years at our infirmary, and passed away on April 29, 1936 at the age of eighty-four years of age and eleven months.

On January 12, 1996, Rome acknowledged her venerability... After serious studies of her life, it was accepted that she had practised all the vertus heroicolly. When she will be beatified, nothing else will be said, except that the Catholic Church would have recognized a miracle performed through her intercession.

Elisabeth Bergeron is an example of faithfulness to herself and to her dreams as so often said today. She entered wholeheartedly in this great adventure of human life. She has incarnated the strength of the gentle, of the silent people, and the ability of the passionate. She will have helped to build the construction of a practical and loyal city according to the recent expression of Pope François.

We are certain that Venerable Elisabeth Bergeron knew that we needed to be close to our two mothers before the end of their life on earth.

- Our museum was transferred on April 14, 2014. It will be rebuilt in the lateral chapels of the great chapel of the Seminary of Saint-Hyacinthe. It had been inaugurated on June 10, 1999 at our Mother House at 805, Raymond Avenue.
- Seconded by the Bureau of Tourism and Congress of Saint-Hyacinthe, people had provided us with 11000 visitors at the Museum. The Elisabeth-Bergeron museum assured a permanent animation.
- We will conserve with care our precious relics hoping to find them soon in our regional museum of Quebec.
