

Clizabeth Bergeron speaks to us...

Autumn 2018

A meeting at the Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré Basilica

On June 27, 2018, the Sisters of St. Joseph of St. Hyacinthe from Brazil, Lesotho and St. Hyacinthe came together to celebrate a historic moment for the Congregation. Some people associated to their charism were also part of the event.

Mr. Pierre Lussier, artist-painter from Quebec City, made a beautiful painting illustrating Elizabeth Bergeron, foundress of the Sisters of St. Joseph of St. Hyacinthe also called Mother St. Joseph. The canvas occupies an alcove above a door overlooking the Très-Saint-Sacrement Chapel.

Sister Louise Millette, Vice-Postulator, welcomes us to the chapel of the Immaculate Conception and invites us to commence the celebration. The main event of this meeting was the discovery of this painting that was blessed by Canon Claude Lamoureux and to hear the painter, Mr. Pierre Lussier, tell us about his work. Let's listen to him...

« I did not know your Foundress. You told me about her and I admit that I was impressed by this woman, her smiling face deeply inspired me. Thank you for helping me to know her! She became a friend, an inspirer by her great openness to the will of God.

When I start a new painting, I pray to all the painters who are already in heaven to help me in each new achievement.



The key to reading this canvas is horizontality and verticality. The lines converge on the cross that Mother St. Joseph carries; it is she who is in the center. The smiling and joyful face of Mother St. Joseph make us want to praise God through her. The whole picture represents her mission. As a landscape painter, nature is very important in my paintings. You will find the great yellow-gold elm, rural lands, the Yamaska River, birds and flowers. The sky, which is all-encompassing, is the element that speaks of the great goodness of God. Long before us, nature was the cradle of faith.

I painted the second house of your foundation in the left corner. Mother St. Joseph is in the center with a boy and a girl who are very close to her. Her right hand presents Saint Joseph and the Child Jesus whose eyes are closed and express that they are listening to the will of God. There is, on the right of the canvas, a sister and a girl. Another sister was needed because Mother St. Joseph acted in community. This sister represents each one of you.

Today, I told you about what I did to create this painting that represents your foundress. I like to listen to people who look at it and make me discover new realities. It's rewarding for me. I will stop here and listen to you. It's your turn to speak... »
