

Clizabeth Bergeron speaks to us...

Spring 2019

Witness of bold faith, of soothing presence, of active charity Clizabeth Bergeron, an inspiring model for today's world.

Where does Elizabeth's faith come from?

Her faith was drawn from her family, from her mother's heart, who taught her the catechism, who taught her to love the things of God, and from the heart of her father who brought her to the fields, where she loved the smell of cut hay, those fields that also told her the name of God. Faith is first of all a wonder, a fruit of the heart rather than of reason.

Having fallen into good soil, Elizabeth's faith turns out to be bold at the young age of 8: she dares to break the rules, of obedience as well as prudence, to receive Jesus in the Eucharist! Somewhat like the great Teresa of Avila who fled, to meet martyrdom.

At age 15, she became a catechist in American territory where the Bergeron family moved for a time, seeking more profitable jobs than those on their farms.

For a long time she had been thinking of devoting herself to God in religious life. After a first refusal at the Sisters of Charity, she makes short stays with The Sisters of Mercy, The Sisters of the Presentation of Mary, the Sisters of the Precious Blood, but no one accepts her.

The day Elizabeth abandons her personal projects, God will give her an undoubtable sign.

This sign comes by Bishop Louis-Zephirin Moreau who asks her to establish a community of religious teachers. To her, who cannot write! She is dismayed! It is in prayer, at the base of the crucifix, that she will discern the will of God expressed by her bishop: she accepts it in surrender and trust. From that moment on, peace and serenity settle and grow in her. A joyous certainty invades her, which will inhabit her until her death.

More and more, her faith will take root in the present moment, the sacrament of the divine on her beyond her own evidences. She must give up her dreams of contemplative life to establish an active community, go towards the unknown of this foundation by "bringing nothing" as "girls of the providence", to be subjected to the mockery of the population and the clergy, to be relieved from her duties, to serve in the least of tasks and especially to endure!

Accept this endurance without glory for all those years of which we know almost nothing (somewhat like the life of Saint Joseph), of which we have kept only some hesitant signatures, all those years that we summarize by the words: kindness, service, prayer, humility, good advice, encouragement and joy.

Soothing presence

Mother Saint-Joseph, except for the decade preceding the end of her life, will be a member of the "General Council". When the superior visits the schools in the parishes, she accompanies him and meets the children. This good mother is very interested in them, she recommends to the Sisters to be good and understanding, insisting: "It is necessary that the children like school, otherwise, they will not succeed"!

Everywhere, Elizabeth appeases situations: she does not tolerate criticism, neither between the Sisters, nor towards persons outside the community. She prevents storms when she says: the truth does not suppress charity, if someone has done wrong, there is no need to publish it without good reason.

Elizabeth's heart is in perfect accord with Jesus' heart. This makes her bold and necessarily active, not only for the children, but also the sick, the poor, the missionaries, the priests. The whole life of Elizabeth was one of active charity.
