Contemporary Influence of Elizabeth Bergeron

To talk to us about the contemporary influence of Elizabeth Bergeron, Sister Thérèse asked herself the following questions...

"How is Elizabeth Bergeron still reaching us today?"
"How can this humble woman influence our lives?"

Let us see how she perceives this woman, still active today, 86 years after her death.

A Simple Woman

With Elizabeth, all is simple, starting by her birth in a rural area, her clothing without any pretension, her education more than summary, her work shared between the house and the farm work. During her stay in the United States, same simplicity of life. As foundress of a community, she remains loyal to herself: humble and simple. She has nothing to prove and never seeks to show off. It is for God that she acts, and it is Him she recognizes in the people surrounding her.

In these times where luxury, comfort, overconsumption are in the spotlight, Elizabeth invites us to the simplicity of life, that is to say a life marked by authenticity and honesty; to a life decluttered from the superfluous, liberated from false needs and useless accumulations; to a life of simplicity that leads to freedom and is manifested in great serenity.

The simplicity of life, it is, first and foremost, life as it is and not life as dreamed. This simplicity will give us the ability to cope with what life has in store for us that is beautiful and good.

A Humble Woman

Elizabeth possessed a true humility. This humility came from her profound faith, the conviction of knowing she was where God wanted her. The humility of Elizabeth made her clear about herself. Aware of her limits, she knows how to ask for advice and recognize her weaknesses. If she wounds any of her companions, she immediately apologizes. Never did she invoke her title of the foundress. She said: "I am nothing, but the Lord was willing to use me. We must not disappoint Him. I am only an instrument in his hands."

We could add that her humility was heroism. As if it had not been enough for Elizabeth to spend her life in the shadow of Mgr. Moreau, of carrying the weight of ignorance and a state of poor health, she welcomes, without losing her peace, the jibes from the people outside, the insults and even the calumnies.

To the oversize ambition that seems to be the law in all fields today, Elizabeth comes and says, "What is weak in the world, this is what God chooses to build his Kingdom."

A Woman Capable of Humour

This virtue has always characterized Elizabeth. One day, a nurse asks her, "What did you do to catch that nasty cold?" She responds to her, "I got it for free." Elizabeth often experienced health problems. She, who yet was refused in several communities, precisely for health issues, supported that we could very well live in community even with a fragile health.

One day, a nun announces her intention of leaving the community, because she has some health too frail. The foundress answers her point-blank, "Know, my sister, that the cracked pots, we use them carefully." Afterwards, this nun went to found a mission of the Sisters of St. Joseph in Africa, in Lesotho, and she died at 86.

At the 50th anniversary of the foundation, it is about reserved seats at the distinguished guests' table. A sister says to her, "What will you do at this table of honour, among the dignitaries?" "Like the others," she says, "eat." What an aptness! Also, she invites us to not take ourselves too seriously, and especially to put a bit of humour in our daily plate: it de-dramatizes, it is refreshing, it relaxes and most importantly, it gives a good taste...

An Audacious Woman

Audacious Elizabeth who plans everything to hurry the days of her first communion. Audacious Elizabeth who accepts to found a teaching community while she could not sign her name, because she did not know how to write. Audacious Elizabeth who, at the age of 14, welcomes a poor, lends him the clothes of her father, and prepares him dinner. Audacious Elizabeth, who, from the beginning to the end of her life, remains attentive to the needs of her time and responds to it with enthusiasm and faith.

Is this audacity not still relevant today? Faced with the changes in the life habits, faced with the major issues on which the current world needs to address, faced with the urgent challenges that society, family and the Church have to overcome, she can inspire us, for sometimes bold choices are necessary. The actions that this woman took, in extreme poverty and with makeshift means, should serve us as a lesson or, at least, provide us a reason for admiring her.

A Church Woman

Elizabeth's whole life was a listening and a response: listening and answering the call of God first, then to those of the Church and finally to the ones of the children and the abandoned youth. Elizabeth often said, "Thank you, my God, for having made me child of your Church." For her, the Church was Christ and his brothers and sisters to serve. This love held her in a continued availability to collaborate with the bishops and priests and to respond to the needs of the Church. Always did she encourage her daughters to help the priests of the parishes.

Are we bearing, like Elizabeth, the constant preoccupation to update our commitment as baptized? It can be lived in different ways: for instance, by supporting the pastors and pastoral animators with our prayer, by involving ourselves in organisms that fight for a better world and, most importantly, by making us close to the people around us.
