To highlight this anniversary, on Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> of April, people are invited to come and participate in the activities that will take place at the mausoleum, the site where our Venerable Elizabeth Bergeron is resting.

### **May 25: Birth of Elizabeth, 175 Years Ago**

Something to be celebrated: 175 years... On Monday, May 25<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m., a Thanksgiving mass will be celebrated at the Church of La Presentation, the place where our foundress Elizabeth Bergeron was baptized, on the very same day of her birth. You are cordially invited to join the Sisters of St. Joseph of St. Hyacinthe and their associated people.



Moreover, on April 29<sup>th</sup>, a Thanksgiving mass will be celebrated in our residence named “Les Jardins d’Aurélié” in communion with all the people who put their trust in Elizabeth.

Elizabeth is still well alive in the heart of her daughters and just as much in the heart of people coming to visit her at the mausoleum, as well as for all those people from everywhere who pray her, confide in her and ask her physical and spiritual healing.
