In Heaven with Elizabeth and Noëlla



The title of this newsletter is well: "Elizabeth Bergeron speaks to us," isn't it? Then, the newsletter that you have in your hands wants to be a dialogue testimony between Sister Elizabeth Bergeron and Sister Noëlla Poudrette, deceased on past February 14. Sister Noëlla, a woman of the heart, left us on St. Valentine's Day to go encounter her Loved One. I imagine her in presence of Mother St. Joseph (*Elizabeth Bergeron*), both of them in a heart-to-heart with the Lord and us.



N— "What a joy when I was told: let us go to the house of the Lord!" (Psalm 121)

E— "My little sister Noëlla, how happy am I to hold you in my arms and to welcome you in this place, 'where the good Lord has prepared a place for you."

N— Oh! Good Mother Elizabeth, it is a great happiness for me to be welcomed by you!

E— "So am I, Sister Noëlla. For 32 years, you have welcomed and written to the people from everywhere to make me known: thousands of letters, emails and phone calls received, and thousands of encounters at the tomb. I am profoundly moved for this humble work of correspondence and for your welcoming, lived in goodwill and simplicity from the heart when people came to the mother house, and after the moving, to the residence 'Les Jardins d'Aurélie' to obtain favours. Your zeal was limitless, my dear daughter."

N — It was a blessing for me, Mother St. Joseph!

E— "I see, in your look and by your smile, all the pride you felt to speak of me by making the visit of the tomb where my remains exhumed are resting. All this devotion to make me known, and especially so that the people obtain favours through my intercession, to diminish their sorrow, their suffering, their loneliness, find peace of heart, and what else..."



N—Good Mother, I am doubly parent with you: being from the eleventh generation of your family on the maternal side, I entered the community of the Sisters of St. Joseph of St. Hyacinthe, which you have founded to the request of Monsignor Louis-Zéphirin Moreau, to assure the education of the children from our remotest parishes. By teaching to this youth, I was answering your request "of being good for my students, especially the poorest ones and the less talented," for you were saying: "It is by goodness that you will win the hearts and do good to them. See Our Lord in each one of them."

E— "In my time, educational conditions did not enable me to learn how to write. It did not prevent me from making myself close to the needy! ... Just like you, my dear daughter! By making yourself 'close' because the good Lord is making Himself close to us."

N — I had an excellent model, good Mother St. Joseph! And speaking about you filled me with joy while serving my brothers and my sisters in simplicity and humility.

E— "I am rejoicing of this with you, Sister Noëlla! It is another reason to give thanks to God of which the will wants to be overflowing of mercy and love for all human beings."

N— "My soul magnifies the Lord, for He has regarded the low estate of His servant'. (Luke 1:46) Mother Elizabeth, by speaking of you with my students, I experienced spiritual relations and profound friendships that made me develop and grow...

E— "Yes, my daughter, and, thanks to your patience, your gentleness and your support at all times, your dear students received and experienced comfort and hope. In the happy moments of a marriage, a baptism or a sadder event like the death of a loved one, you did support, accompany and encourage these people who needed a good intention and loyal presence.'

N— "The Lord is my shepherd: therefore can I lack nothing." (Psalm 22) I am feeling so blessed. It is Him who did all this through me...

E— "We are from His family, and by the grace of His Spirit, He sends us to bring His Good News... And His Gospel is doing so even today."
