At the Mausoleum with Elizabeth and Catherine-Aurelie



Here we are at the Mausoleum of the Catholic cemetery of the Saint-Hyacinthe Cathedral. Two sisters have lived there: one since October 30, 2014, Elizabeth Bergeron and the other since August 17, 2018, Mother Catherine-Aurelie-of-the-Precious-Blood, born Aurelie Caouette. They are two women from our region, they are Maskoutains.



I have been seeing them both since Mother Catherine-Aurelie arrived in August 2018. What a surprise! Yes, I have heard them talk about how happy they are to be together. When we enter the mausoleum, on the right is Elisabeth or Mother Saint-Joseph for people who know her by this name. On the left, when we go past the stairs, is Mother Catherine-Aurelie. They have so much to tell us: **“I would like hearts that will give love for love to Jesus. »** (Catherine-Aurelie). **“What is weak in the world, God has chosen it to confound what is strong. »** 1Cor. 1, 27 (Elizabeth Bergeron). One like the other carrying what God expected of them. The confidence of a heart turned toward the invisible Presence, especially in times of darkness. Are they not seekers of God? I believe that they are well at the Mausoleum because we feel a comforting peace and a deep joy there.

You know, it was on March 16, 1871 that Elisabeth went to the monastery of the Sisters Adorers of the Precious Blood. At the dawn of her 20s, she begins her postulate. She wants to give herself entirely to Jesus in prayer. The advice of Mother Catherine-Aurelie is immediately acted upon by the young Elisabeth. She thus spends long hours before the Blessed Sacrament and this fills her with joy and peace. However, the austere side of the contemplative life does not favor Elisabeth's delicate health. After a few months, Mother Catherine-Aurelie told her that her place was not between the walls of the monastery. Fervent and continuous prayer will help her find her way because God has reserved her for another mission.

Finding a place to live your relationship with God has proven to be extremely difficult. Bishop Louis-Zephirin Moreau invites her to found a community of educators for children in rural areas of the diocese of Saint-Hyacinthe. What wisdom in Mother Catherine-Aurelie, to have seen and sensed through Elisabeth's limits, openness to a vocational call other than the monastery.

Today, I hear them say to each other: "Here we are gathered, together to welcome visitors who need listening and healings of all kinds ..." Yes, what a wonderful sign of the presence of the Spirit of Jesus animated these two women! This same Spirit also brings us together under the same roof in the gardens of the Sisters Adorers of the Precious Blood, at the residence "Les Jardins d'Aur lie". Who would have believed it? Our two communities now form a community of contemplative and apostolic sisters, since 2014. What a wonderful wink from our Venerable Foundresses, isn't it?

Elizabeth and Catherine-Aur lie invite us to visit them at the Mausoleum, at 1075 rue Girouard Est, to offer them our requests or simply rest in front of their image and their tomb. Welcome! Please sign your name in the notebook each time you visit.
